Getting started with **libby**

The Libby app is a new, one-tap reading app for borrowing digital books and audiobooks from your library.

This free app, created by OverDrive, is available for Android, iOS (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch), and Windows 10 devices.

Install the Libby app from your device's app store.

Open the app and **find** your library.

Browse the library's collection and borrow titles. Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf**. Watch for checkout periods before downloading to the app. The checkout period you select will be your default going forward.

From your **Shelf**, you can:

- Tap **Start Reading** or **Start Listening** to open a title.
- Tap the cover image, then **Send to Device** to send a book to Kindle.

Location Search Tips:

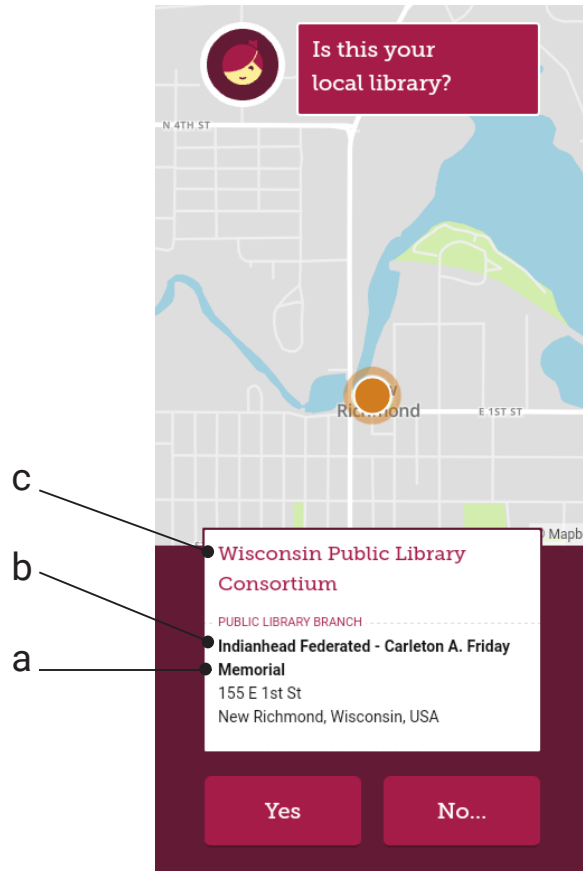
Carleton A. Friday Memorial Library^a is part of the Indianhead Federated Library System^b which is part of the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium^c.

Easy Navigation: at the bottom of the page you can keep browsing or find the titles you have checked out on your shelf.



Managing Titles: tap a cover image in your shelf for options to open the book, renew it, return it to the library, or send it to Kindle.



Search Preferences: tap the + to open the preferences to narrow your search. Tap the **search bar** and then tap **More** to open advanced search options such as format, subjects, special titles, and date added.
